MOTION TO SUPPRESS

NOW INTO COURT comes, Defendant, LESLIE C. THOMPSON, who moves this Honorable Court to suppress the evidence and all statements allegedly made by him on the following grounds:

1.

On November 9, 2011, defendant, LESLIE C. THOMPSON, was charged with violating, R.S. 14:35 simple battery.

2.

Mover asserts that on the day of his arrests Mover was not advised of his Miranda rights. Prior to this charge and doing arrest Mover was questioned and gave statements without being informed about his Miranda rights.

Mover asserts that all confessions or statements made by Mover be suppressed due to them being obtained in an unduly manner in that mover was not Mirandized which is contrary to law.

Defendant further asserts that prior to interrogation pre and post arrest he was not advised of his Miranda Rights.


