SECTION III

All ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION IV

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN, that no official or employee shall be permitted to expend any amount in excess of the said budget as herein established unless the revenue of the said Town shall be received from other sources to provide for the said excess expenditures, and not then unless same shall be submitted to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen for approval.

SECTION V

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Jonesboro that if any item or provision, including and section, exception, part, phrase or term, or the application thereof is held invalid, the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby and the validity of this ordinance in any and all other respects shall not be affected thereby. If any phrase, clause, word or other portion of this ordinance is held invalid or to be unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity shall be limited to that portion of the ordinance.
