


Lincoln Parish Courthouse Evaluation

The existing Courthouse was constructed in 1949. The existing building is constructed of a reinforced concrete structure with brick veneer exterior walls. The existing building has a number of construction issues that include the following:

- 1 Elevator
- 2 ADA Accessibility
- 3 Exterior envelope problems including windows and other fenestrations.
- 4 Roof (only roof to have been replaced in the last 16 years was over large Courtroom).
- 5 Aged mechanical and electrical systems (an upgrade to many of the electrical panels and HVAC equipment was done in 1995).
- 6 Dated interior finishes.
- 7 Plumbing issues with sewer stoppage problems on 1st and 2nd floor that continue to re-occur.
- 8 Return air path problems on 1st floor.
- 9 Lack of physical space.

Buildings in Louisiana where the cost of renovated and/or new improvements exceed 50% of the value of the existing building have to be brought up to current code standards. This requirement will require major renovation of the entire building.








Lincoln Parish Police Jury Complex Evaluation

The existing building was constructed around 1980. The building is constructed of structural steel with brick veneer exterior walls. The existing building is in fairly good condition with few code related issues. Parking for the building is adequate. The first floor of the building was recently renovated for the Assessor's space. The majority of the HVAC system was replaced approximately four (4) years ago. Some renovation work is required on the second and third floor. The major issue with the building is the roof is currently in need of replacement.



Federal Building Evaluation

This existing building was constructed in 1909. This solid, rectangular structure was the first one to be built in Ruston with Indiana limestone. The Renaissance architecture and Anglo-American theme gives the building its stately presence and contributes to the historic flavor of downtown Ruston. The building has a number of construction issues that include the following:

- 1 ADA accessibility.
- 2 Exterior envelope problems including windows and fenestrations.
- 3 Roof (The building has both sloping slate shingles and built-up roof areas. Both roofing types need complete replacement).
- 4 Aged mechanical and electrical systems and lack of equipment control.
- 5 Dated interior finishes that in some cases have had damage related to through wall moisture infiltration leaks, as well as roof leaks.
- 6 Plumbing problems.


Even though the required work is both extensive and expensive on this type of structure, the Architect feels that the building should remain in use and the money spent to renovate the building.




Federal Building south vienna - ruston, Louisiana



Annex 1 Evaluation

It is estimated that the existing building was constructed around 1960. The building is a wood framed building with brick veneer exterior. The building was completely renovated in 1999. The building is in relatively good condition since the renovation. The location of the building is adjacent to the main Courthouse and has adequate parking. Minor renovation would be required to house different Parish functions that currently exist in this space.




Annex 2 Evaluation

The existing building was constructed in approximately 1940. The building is a wood frame building with brick veneer exterior. The building has undergone cosmetic renovations in the past; however, the building has several construction issues. These issues include:


- 1 No elevator access to the second floor
- 2 ADA accessibility
- 3 Stair
- 4 Aged mechanical and electrical systems
- 5 Dated finishes
- 6 Exterior Envelope problems including roof
- 7 Inadequate parking

Due to the age and condition of the building and the difficulty and expense involved in renovating this building, the Architect would recommend that the Parish sell this building or retain the building primarily for its site use in the future.



Former County Market Evaluation

The existing original building was constructed in the 1960's. The building is constructed of a steel frame with brick veneer and flat roof. The majority of the building is leased, with other areas used by parish agencies. The building has numerous construction issues that include the following:

- 1 Water through wall infiltration at lower level.
- 2 Roof and deck problems.
- 3 Low quality original construction that has not held up well through the years.
- 4 Inadequate structural floor framing members on east end of the building.
- 5 Aged HVAC and electrical systems and lack of adequate control systems.
- 6 Dated interior finishes.

Due to the age and condition of the existing building, it is recommended that the building be removed at the end of the lease periods, and that only emergency repairs be made on the building until that time.
