AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 177-97-(8) OF THE PARISH OF LINCOLN STATE OF LOUISIANA PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE PARISH OF LINCOLN, STATE OF LOUISIANA, BE AMENDED BY REVISING CHAPTER 3, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, TO AMEND SECTION 3-7.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE POLICE JURY OF LINCOLN PARISH, LOUISIANA, IN REGULAR SESSION CONVENED THIS _____ DAY OF _____, 2017:

Sec. 3-7. Public Possession or Consumption.

It shall be unlawful for any person to consume or possess any alcohol beverage of any kind on any street or highway or in any public place, including but not limited to, any property owned by the parish. The following location is exempt from the prohibitions of this section: The consumption and possession of alcoholic beverages is permitted at or within Lincoln Hall which is located at 149 Fairgrounds Road, Dubach, Louisiana under such terms and conditions as the Lincoln Parish Police Jury may impose for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public, and in compliance with all state and local Alcoholic Beverage Laws. Public possession does not include the possession or consumption of any alcoholic beverage under the following circumstances:

- (1) For an established religious purpose;
- (2) For medical purposes prescribed or administered by a licensed physician, pharmacist, dentist, nurse, hospital, or medical institution;
- (3) In private residences.
