## COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT

This Agreement made by and between:

CITY OF RUSTON, LOUISIANA, a municipal corporation of the State of Louisiana, whose address is Post Office Box 2069, Ruston, Louisiana 71273 appearing herein by and through Ronny Walker, its duly authorized Mayor,

hereinafter referred to as "City", and

LINCOLN PARISH POLICE JURY, a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, domiciled in Lincoln Parish, Louisiana, whose address is Post Office Box 979, Ruston, Louisiana 71273 appearing herein by and through the undersigned and duly authorized representative,

hereinafter referred to as "Police Jury", who have agreed as follows:

WHEREAS, a catastrophic storm including a tornado (the "Storm") occurred on April 25, 2019 in the City of Ruston ("City"), resulting in severe damage to various City facilities and subsequent disaster related debris ("Debris").

WHEREAS, the Police Jury currently operates the Lincoln Parish Landfill (the "Landfill") to dispose of Debris from the City.

**WHEREAS**, the City is utilizing all of its trash and dump trucks to handle Debris removal and disposal resulting from the Storm.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City and the Police Jury agree to coordinated joint efforts in storm debris removal as follows:

## A. City Obligations:

- 1. Organize handling efforts (bottom of page cut off).
- 2. Provide seven (7) trash trucks and up to five (5) dump trucks and loaders.
- 3. Provide fuel for all City and Parish trucks.

## B. Police Jury Obligations:

- 1. Provide up to four (4) insured trash trucks and drivers for handle debris removal and disposal.
- 2. Provide all Landfill tickets to City to claim in national disaster declaration with FEMA.
- 3. Claim all labor for services on the disaster declaration claims with FEMA.
- 4. Burn or otherwise dispose of all Debris at the Landfill at no cost to the City.
